### **Fire Awareness Training - (2 hours)**

**Aim:** The aim of the course is to improve the fire safety knowledge of staff and to familiarise students with the basic requirements of the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005.

The training consists of the following elements:

- The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 - Employer and Employee responsibilities;
- Fire Risk Assessment - Informative element explaining that these have been carried out for each premises;
- Fire Awareness - Explanation of the Triangle of Combustion followed by a Video Presentations to illustrate the rapid nature of smoke and fire development and spread, and an explanation of the nature of a Flashover and a Backdraught;
- Fire Evacuation Plans - Generic explanation of Evacuation Procedures explaining how these work and sign posting to the specific plans for each premises.

### **Fire Warden Training - (3 hours)**

**Aim:** The aim of the course is to improve the fire safety knowledge of anyone involved in the management of fire safety in any workplace and to familiarise students with the basic requirements of the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005.

The training consists of the following elements:

- The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 - Employer and Employee responsibilities;
- Fire Risk Assessment - Informative element explaining how these are conducted, how they can contribute to the reduction of risk & that these have been carried out for each premises;

- Fire Awareness - Explanation of the Triangle of Combustion followed by a Video Presentations to illustrate the rapid nature of smoke and fire development and spread, and an explanation of the nature of a Flashover and a Backdraught;
- Fire Evacuation Plans - Generic explanation of Evacuation Procedures explaining how these work and sign posting to the specific plans for each premises;
- Protecting People and Property;
- Portable Fire Extinguishers - Explanation of the different types, how they are used and when it is permissible to use them. This includes Video Presentations on the use of extinguishers followed by a practical handling and use session;
- The Role of the Fire Warden.
